

World Parkinson Congress Photography/Taping Permission Form

Photography/Videotaping/Audio Taping Policy

Registered media with badges who have obtained permission through the Media Room are the only attendees permitted to audiotape sessions (except for those who have obtained written permission from the guest lecturer beforehand).

Photographing and videotaping in the Exhibit Hall is strictly prohibited; photographing, audio taping, and videotaping during sessions is only permitted with the expressed consent of WPC. To videotape other content on-site, a media representative from WPC must accompany when any videotaping occurs.

Audiotapes may be purchased through the official on-site audiotape vendor.

Permission for Photography/Videotaping/Audio Taping

All registered media who intend to audio tape/videotape and/or photograph sessions during the World Parkinson Congress must first obtain permission.

- Permission must be secured from the individual presenter or author.
- Data (slides, transparencies, posters, etc.) may not be visible in any videotape or photograph aired or published.
- The WPC and the presenter/author must be advised of the publication venue and date. Copies may be sent to Melissa Haynes, Media Relations Coordinator, WPC, 2025 M St., NW, Suite 800, Washington, DC 20036-3309, USA.
- All audiotapes, videotapes, and photographs are for one-time use as background for media stories related to the World Parkinson's Congress. Taped and photographed information must be identified as originating from/presented at the Congress
- All audiotapes, videotapes, and photographs originating from the WPC may not be sold or distributed.
